CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST No.000109/ASMI/CCAA/DG/PDST/SPM/06-20 FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANT FOR THE POSITION OF CIVIL ENGINEER WITHIN THE TRANSPORT SECTOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECT - AIR COMPONENT

- This call for expression of interest follows the General Procurement Notice of this Project published in United Nations Development Business Online (UNDB online) of 03 November 2016.
- The Government of the Republic of Cameroon has received funding from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD),** to finance the Transport Sector Development Project (PDST). The Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority (CCAA), Public Administrative Institution and Implementing Agency of the Air Component of the PDST, intends to apply part of the proceeds to finance the services of an individual Consultant to the position of Civil Engineer of the PDST-AC.
- Objective of the Study**
The main objective of the Transport Sector Development Project (PDST) is to contribute to the reinforcement of the planning integrated to multimodal transport and improvement of efficiency and road and air transport safety.
The project is structured around four (04) main components:
Component 1: Capacity-building of public administration in the planning of intermodal transport infrastructures, in the context of technical assistance;
Component 2: Reconstruction of the Badiou-Bamenda road section, the most degraded section of the regional corridor linking Yaoundé to the West border of Cameroon with Nigeria;
Component 3: Setting-up of a second generation road fund;
Component 4 : Strengthening security around Yaoundé, Douala, Garoua and Maroua airports, in accordance with standards and practices recommended by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).
- Mandate of the Consultant**
The services of the Consultant shall include:
- Checking all technical opinions (work completion file presented by the company; intervention methodology ; work schedule, etc..) given by Consultants and Companies that intervene in the Project's construction work;
- Monitoring the execution of all construction and/or structure rehabilitation activities in relation to the various stakeholders ;
- Participating in the development of the quarterly or annual programme of activities and development of the AWPB ;
- Participating in the drafting of quarterly reports highlighting the evolution and progress of construction work;
- Ensuring the regular transmission to the Bank or the Government of all documents required as part of the work and information on their implementation, progress and difficulties ;
- Participating in working sessions convened by the PMU or any other departments of the PMU, liable to bring new ideas for the smooth functioning of the Project ;
- Monitoring the technical execution of work and ensuring the organization and proper functioning to guarantee the achievement of expected results;
- Ensuring monitoring, analysis and validation of technical reports produced by Consultants and Companies that intervene in the Project's construction work and proposing the corresponding technical observations that constitute the PMU's opinion ;
- Providing any other technical assistances to the Project ;
- Participating in the provisional and definitive acceptance of structures;
- Performing any other specific tasks that may be requested by the hierarchy.
- The Director General of the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority (CCAA),** hereby invites (Individual) Consultants admissible to express their interest for the provision of the services described above. Interested Consultants shall provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform these services (Dated and signed CV cover letter, and supporting documents for any reference listed). The PMU reserves the right to check the authenticity of information communicated.
- Essential Evaluation Criteria**
The consultant shall:
- Be holder of a degree in Civil Engineering (Minimum CCEAL +5) ;
- Be registered with the National Order of Civil Engineers (ONIGC) ;
- Have a general professional experience of at least (10) years in the field of Civil Engineering;
- Have a specific experience of at least five (05) years in the monitoring of road projects and civil engineering structures ;
- Have a specific experience of at least three (03) years in the monitoring of construction of High-Rise Buildings (HRB) ;
- Have good organizational and self-reliance skills;
- Be able to work in a team and under pressure;
- Have a good practice of Microsoft Office Software and Civil Engineering specialized software (AutoCAD, Robobat, or any other structural design and drawing software) ;
- Have a perfect command of English and French, the use of the other language being an asset.
- Consultants are informed that the provisions of Paragraph 1.9 "Guidelines : Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers as part of IBRD loans and IDA Credits and Grants, January 2011", "Guidelines for Consultants", relevant to the World Bank Rules on Conflicts of Interest, shall apply.
- The Consultant shall be selected according to individual consultants' selection method as described in the Guidelines for Consultants.
